We care for little ones from 15 months to five years old, offering a flexible range of options to suit your family's needs. Whether you choose our half-day program 07:15 - 13:00 or our full-day option 07:15 - 17:15, you can select two, three, or five days per week, making it easy to fit into your busy schedule.

## ENROLMENT FEE

The annual Enrolment Fee of R950 secures your child's spot at Little Piece of Heaven and ensures we can continue providing the best environment for their growth and learning. This fee supports vital areas such as administrative costs, maintaining our high standards, enhancing our school space and updating educational materials and toys every year. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid yearly to confirm your child's place. We appreciate your understanding of this important step in the enrolment process.

## OPERATING FEE

The annual Operating Fee of R950 is due in January or during your child's first month of attendance each year. This fee helps cover essential items like stationery, daily necessities such as tissues and wipes, first aid supplies and cleaning and sanitization materials. We're happy to share that families don't need to supply any additional products during the year. Please note that this fee is non-refundable. Thank you for your support in helping us maintain a clean, safe and well-equipped environment for your little ones.

## EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY BOOKS

Our Grade RR children will utilize an Educational Writing Book to enhance cognitive and fine motor development. The cost of the writing book is R100 and invoices will be issued in January.

## NURSERY SCHOOL FEE STRUCTURE

The monthly fee must be paid in advance on or before the third day of each month, covering all 12 consecutive months of the year. Little Piece of Heaven retains the right to levy interest on all overdue accounts.

## AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Little Piece of Heaven provides an After School Care service for all attending children, available from 13:00 to 17:15. The initial hour incurs a charge of R40 per child, with subsequent hours billed at R35 per hour.

## NURSERY SCHOOL HOURS

Little Piece of Heaven strives to create a smooth and enjoyable experience for everyone, starting and ending each day on a positive note. Our operating hours are from 07:15 to 13:00 for half-day enrolments and from 07:15 to 17:15 for full-day enrolments.

To ensure a prompt start to our daily activities, we kindly request that all children arrive by 08:50, so we can begin the day at 09:00. For our half-day children, we'd appreciate it if pickups could be made by 12:45, allowing us to end the day on a cheerful note with a story.

If you anticipate being late for pick-up, please contact us in advance so we can make suitable arrangements. Please note, that a late fee will be applicable if your child is not collected on time, R40 for every 10 minutes for half-day children and R60 for full-day children. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in helping us maintain a smooth schedule for all. Thank you for your support in ensuring that each day is both enjoyable and well-organized for your little one.

## PARKING

At Little Piece of Heaven, your child's safety is our top priority. To ensure this, we follow a Traffic Management Plan and have a few parking guidelines in place. When leaving the nursery school, we kindly ask that you hold your little one's hand and keep them close as you walk to your car.

To keep things running smoothly, please avoid parking on the roadside. If no parking bays are available, your patience is greatly appreciated. Feel free to circle the crescent until a spot opens up. Let's all be considerate by thinking of others and parking thoughtfully, so more families can safely use the parking area. We'd love your help in spreading this important message to all families collecting their little ones. Together, we can ensure a safe and happy experience for everyone. ## NURSERY SCHOOL SAFETY

At Little Piece of Heaven, safety comes first, and we truly appreciate your help in keeping all our little stars safe and sound:

Here are a few important guidelines to follow:

- Close the gate: Please ensure the gate is securely closed behind you, every time
- No solo exits: Children should never leave or pass through the gate without a parent
- Drop-off love: Walk your child to the front gate, where a friendly teacher will be waiting with a warm welcome
- Hand in hand: When leaving, hold your little one's hand and keep them close as you walk to your car
- No strangers: Only authorized individuals may pick up your child. Please let us know in advance if someone new will be collecting them

## REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD

Kindly provide the following items:

- A small bag for personal belongings, with a name tag
- A lunchbox containing a healthy snack for 10:00
- A small bottle of water, juice, or milk for 10:00
- An additional set of labelled clothes in a plastic bag
- A plastic bag for wet or soiled clothes
- A pack of baby wipes is stored in the bag for emergencies

For full-day enrolments, please include:

- A small mattress with two fitted sheets and a blanket, which is kept at school and washed weekly
- An extra snack and additional juice/water for the afternoon

For our little friends 15 – 30 months, please include:

- A small muslin blanket for summer sleeping
- Milk bottles, dummies, nappies, wipes and cream – clearly marked

Your attention to these details ensures a comfortable and well-prepared experience for your child during their time at Little Piece of Heaven.

## EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Play is the heart of learning, from building block towers to exploring kinetic sand and enjoying jungle gyms. Through play, children develop problem-solving skills, creativity and social interactions while having loads of fun.

- Our **Music and Movement sessions** not only bring rhythm and joy but also strengthen listening skills, concentration, coordination and the ability to follow instructions, all while building confidence and self-expression.

Birthdays are extra special at Little Piece of Heaven and we can't wait to help your child celebrate. Feel free to send cake, cupcakes, or any tasty treats to share with their class friends on their big day.

## BAKE & MAKE

Our Bake & Make sessions are a blast. Our children get to create delicious treats inspired by our weekly theme. This fun activity teaches kids a variety of skills, from measuring and pouring to sharing and following simple recipes.

## ENTREPRENEURS DAY

Each child will have the chance to be an Entrepreneur and to make a creative item at home with their parents and then sell it to their classmates for R2 per item. It's a fun way to practice those entrepreneurial skills and build confidence. Please send a small purse or wallet with 25 x R2 coins by February 2025 to join in the excitement. This not only gives them a chance to buy special treats from their fellow entrepreneurs but also teaches valuable life skills like budgeting, sharing and teamwork.



## EXCURSIONS & VISITS TO LITTLE PIECE OF HEAVEN

At Little Piece of Heaven, we love mixing fun with learning. We organize exciting outings and visits throughout the year that are both educational and memorable. These outings are a fantastic opportunity for your child to explore new environments, have a blast and gain valuable learning experiences outside the classroom. They also offer parents a chance to connect with one another and join in the fun.

We will share all the details about these adventures well in advance and we encourage your child's participation to make the most of these experiences. Please note that these outings are special and as such, the Nursery School will be closed during these events as all staff will be accompanying the children and their families. Any costs associated with these outings will be communicated ahead of time.

## CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

We recommend dressing your child in comfortable and practical clothes for daily activities at school. Since we love getting messy with play, painting, sand and even a little mud, we ask that children wear clothes that allow them to dive right in! For girls, we suggest wearing ski pants or shorts under dresses and skirts and during the summer, we encourage the freedom of barefoot play to help develop their sensory abilities. As the weather heats up, the children will wear their Little Piece of Heaven sun hats daily to protect them from the sun. In winter, cosy shoes and warm clothing are a must to keep those little ones snug and happy.

## PERSONAL POSSESSIONS

Please make sure to label all personal items, clothing, lunch boxes, water bottles and anything else your child brings with them. If anything gets left behind, we have a "Lost and Found" box at the entrance, but we can't be responsible for misplaced or damaged belongings. We kindly ask that personal toys be left at home, as they can sometimes get lost or broken, leaving little ones feeling sad.

## HYGIENE & ILLNESSES

We prioritize the health and well-being of our entire community. To maintain a clean and safe environment, we follow strict hygiene practices to prevent the spread of illness. Children are required to wash their hands before meals, after playtime and after using the bathroom. Antibacterial stations are conveniently placed throughout the school to support good hygiene and reduce germs.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in ensuring that sick children remain at home for 24 - 48 hours, particularly if they exhibit any symptoms of illness such as fever, sore throat, runny nose, diarrhoea, vomiting, or eye infections. If a child is unwell due to an infectious condition, we will require a doctor's note before they can return to school.

If a child develops symptoms during the day, such as a fever, we will contact parents immediately to arrange for prompt collection. We understand the challenges this may pose, but we kindly request your cooperation to prioritize your child's health and the safety of others.

For preventive care, we recommend deworming every six months, as well as regular hair checks to prevent lice. Keeping children's nails short also contributes to overall hygiene. We truly appreciate your attention to these important health measures and your ongoing support in keeping Little Piece of Heaven a clean, safe and healthy environment for all our children. Together, we ensure a safe space for learning and growth.



## IMMUNISATIONS SCHOOL POLICY

Our Nursery School places a strong emphasis on the importance of childhood vaccinations, to curb the spread of diseases among children. It is our sincere belief that vaccinations are a collective responsibility for the well-being of our community.

We want to assure all parents that our admission process does not favour or discriminate against applicants based on their vaccination status. While we strongly advise adherence to vaccination schedules to prevent the spread of diseases within the school environment, we acknowledge that vaccination decisions rest solely with parents.

## MEDICATION

In compliance with the law, administering medication to children requires explicit parental consent. Please complete the medicine register, providing prescription medication directly to your child's teacher. The administration of medication will be conducted under the vigilant supervision of a teacher. Parents are responsible for signing the medication out in the afternoons. Kindly refrain from leaving any medication in your child's school bag for safety and regulatory reasons. Your cooperation in this matter ensures the well-being and safety of all our children.

## MEDICAL EMERGENCIES


In case of minor injuries, we document the incident in our accident report and communicate with parents. However, in the case of a more serious injury, such as a significant fall or facial injury that may require stitches, we will urgently contact parents to come and collect their child. For major injuries, we will first call for an ambulance and then contact the parents immediately. Your child's safety and well-being are our top priority and we appreciate your understanding and cooperation in keeping our school a safe place for everyone.

## INDEPENDANCE

We believe that fostering independence in young children is like planting seeds that will grow into beautiful, confident little individuals. Every day, we create small but meaningful moments for children to engage in personal tasks like dressing themselves, putting on shoes, or carrying their bags. These little victories, whether it's managing their lunch boxes or helping with their clothes, help build their sense of pride and accomplishment. We encourage these steps of independence, which not only teach life skills but also help boost their self-esteem. At home, we invite you to offer similar opportunities to encourage your child's growing confidence. Of course, if they struggle, we're here to help. It's all about giving them the space to try, learn, and feel empowered as they discover just how capable they are

## RULES & DISCIPLINE

We're a school built on good moral values, where we believe children learn best when they have strong role models. We guide children with respect, kindness and understanding, leading by example, showing them how to behave with compassion and encouraging positive behaviour through gentle methods. While we believe discipline is important for growth, we approach it in a friendly and nurturing manner, focusing on understanding each child's individual needs and helping them grow emotionally and socially at their own pace.



We approach rules and discipline with a gentle, loving touch, always keeping in mind that toddlers are still discovering how the world works. Our goal is to create a nurturing environment where children feel safe, understood and supported as they learn the value of routines and respect. Discipline, for us, is about fostering a sense of security and accomplishment, knowing that children can thrive within clear, consistent boundaries.

When a child displays negative behaviour, we always begin with a friendly reminder and an opportunity to correct it. If needed, we guide them through a "thinking activity," explaining the behaviour and, if necessary, encouraging an apology. The aim is always to bring them back to the activity with understanding, not punishment. However, if behaviour continues to disrupt the group, we'll reach out to parents to collaborate and ensure the best approach for the child's needs. In more serious situations, we keep parents informed so we can work together for the child's growth.

We believe in the power of positive discipline, where mutual respect, fairness and love are at the heart of everything we do. We also know that as parents, you play a vital role and together, we'll create a supportive, happy space where your little one can truly flourish.

## USEABLE REFUSE

We encourage the creative use of various materials for our activities and welcome parents to contribute the following items to the Nursery School.

Items Suitable for Creative Activities:

- Paper: newspapers, magazines, boxes, etc.
- Empty Containers: cartons, paper boxes, empty medicine boxes, toilet rolls, margarine tubs, matchboxes, ice cream containers, small glass bottles, caps, corks, etc.
- Other Products: toilet rolls, reels, knots, wrapping paper, foil, cotton wool, eggshells, wool, ribbon, ice cream sticks, drinking straws, etc.
